2 Samuel 1 (page 222)



The story of King David—who followed God with a whole heart—is told in 2 Samuel.

1st Samuel 31 then 2nd Samuel 1
marks the end of King Saul
and the beginning of King David.

3 things stand out in chapter 1...

1. Saul's demise his own undoing
2. David's regard for the “Lord's Anointed”
3. Genuine sorrow of David

From David we learn we learn that
a **godly heart** handles transition by...

endures the cost

to themselves with patience (v.1, 1Sa 16-31)

embraces the consequences

to others without fear (v.2-16)

eulogizes the casualties

of others with dignity (v.17-27)

He hideth my life in the depths of His love,
